

## **PIGSKIN PARLAY: PAST CHAMPIONS & BEST PERCENTAGE WINNERS**

(Note: The records you will see below are from what I was able to find dating back to 1999. Now I think we may have done the Parlay a year earlier, but I believe it was only over the last 10 weeks of the 1998 season, a test run if you will. At this time, I'm unable to locate those records. I hope you enjoy the ride looking back at the league over the years, it was fun putting it together. The Commish)

### **Past Parlay Masters & Best Percentage Winners**

**1999:** Touchwood.Com (104 Pnts.); Pooner & Sushi tied for Best %: (58.8%/17 wks)

**2000 (aka Y2K):** Cleveland Steamer (79); Wolverine (61.1/18) Note: Cleveland Steamers hit a backside 3-3 in Week 17 to edge DB Cooper who hit a 4-4/5-5 in the final week)

**2001:** The Clipper (433); Hey Beerman! (60.3/17) Note: The Clipper hit an amazing 4-4/9-9 in Week 17 to beat Zorba who hit a 4-4/3-3 in the final week. The really amazing thing about "The Clipper's" card was that he actually hit 13 different games, imagine if he had played that in Vegas!!

**2002:** Eggholes (117); Broken Tee (64.1/16)

**2003:** The Duffer (118); Cinco DeLaro (62.5/16)

**2004:** C&E (143); Councilman (66.2/17)

**2005:** Moisties (79); TWS.Com & C&E (57.4/17)

**2006:** The Duffer (117); Tennis Bum (55.9/17)

**2007:** Moose Drool (104); Cinco DeLaro (61.8/17) Note: Moose Drool hit a 4-4/6-6 on the last week.

**2008:** Sparky (111); Sparky (66.2/17) Note: 1<sup>st</sup> player to win both Parlay & Best %

**2009:** Smitty (98); Mr.Wizard (63.2/17) Note: Smitty went into the final week leading, he hit a backside 3-3 which he needed because DB Cooper who was in 2<sup>nd</sup> place but only 6 points behind also hit a backside 3-3. Had he not hit, DB Cooper would have won 92-91.

**2010:** C&E (91); Bach, Dawg & Yo Gano (61.8/17)

**2011:** Cinco DeLaro (117); Dukemyster & Penrod (63.2/17)

**2012:** The Stud (91); Smitty, Wiz-Bang & Caban Club (58.8/17)

**2013:** Caban Club (91); Dawg (60.3/17)

**2014:** Sparky (78); Sparky (63.2/17) Note: Sparky became the 2<sup>nd</sup> and only player thus far to win the Parlay & Best %. Sparky hit a 4-4 in week 17 to tie (in points) Pocket Rockets and Trifucta and ended up winning the crown based on tie-breaker points, making it the first time and only time that tie-breaker points decided the Parlay Championship.

**2015:** Mr. Wiz-Bang! (169); Ollie Tabooger (61.8/17)

2016: Pigskinologist (104); Dukemyster (63.2/17) Note: Pigskinologist hit a 4-4 in Week 17 to steal the crown from Caban Club. Although Caban Club and Pigskinologist were tied in parlay points, the Club had a 35-24 tie-breaker point advantage, Pigskinologist had to hit or go home 2<sup>nd</sup> best.

2017: Mr. Wiz-Bang! (137); Purple Hole (66.2/17)

2018: Kabo (130); Fubar (58.8/17) Note: Kabo hit a 4-4/7-7 on the final week to take home the Parlay Master title, swiping it from the 2<sup>nd</sup> half leader Ben's Boy. A little history, Kabo is the grand-daughter of another Parlay Champion who hit a big card in the final week, The Clipper!
