

## PLAYOFF PIGSKIN PARLAY – 2026

A revised version of Pigskin Parlay was recently conceived as an engaging activity for the playoffs. While the game retains several similarities to the original Pigskin Parlay, there are a few modifications to its format. Participants will utilize two cards: one will focus on spreads and over/unders, while the other will feature player props. Each participant is required to submit a three-team parlay for each card, along with a bonus pick for each 3-team parlay that serves as a multiplier if their three-team parlay is successful. The following section details the specific rules of the game.

- Each player must submit a 3-team parlay using the games listed at the top of the card (CARD 1, which includes spreads and over/unders). Additionally, each player will choose a bonus pick, which serves as a multiplier if the 3-team parlay wins. The bonus pick can be a game already included in the original 3-game parlay or a different one. If the bonus pick is from the original 3-team parlay and the parlay hits, the player's points are doubled. However, if the bonus pick is a new game and all picks win (effectively a 4-team parlay), the player earns a 5X bonus for Card 1. If the bonus pick is a different game but does not win, only the basic 7 points are awarded—no bonus points are collected but the player does earn the basic 7 points.

The player does the same thing for a second card, also a 3-team parlay, but must select only from the Player Props section of the card (called Card 2 on the sheet). The same rules as above apply, each player must submit a 3-team parlay and a bonus pick, and the scoring is the same.

Scoring: for each card, should a player hit the 3-team parlay the player would earn:

- 35 points if the bonus game is different from the submitted 3 teamer
- 14 points if the bonus game is one of the 3 submitted games and,
- 7 points if the bonus game is different from the 3-teamer and is missed

If the three-team parlay is unsuccessful, the bonus game holds no value, as it serves solely as a multiplier; consequently, the player receives zero points for the card(s).

When it comes to the bonus game the cards are independent so the player could select from a game played in the original 3-team parlay on the first card and the different game on the second card (going for a 4-teamer) meaning if they hit both cards plus the bonus game on card 2, they would receive a two times bonus on card one and a five times bonus on card 2 (total points would be  $14+35=49$ ).

Each player will get tie breaker points for each three-team parlay so a max of 6 tiebreaker points are available each week. The tiebreaker points would be used to break ties if needed.

We will do a \$10 entry fee with a 1:10 payout ratio.

The card will be up on the website, and you can call or text in your picks just like you have all season long. Results will be posted up on the website following the week's action. The game will continue through the Super bowl. Below is a sample of how the player should submit picks for each card.
